English

- 1 ½ or 2" binder with 7 dividers (we will organize this together during the first week of school)
- 1- 70 page spiral composition notebook
- a novel list will be distributed during the first week of school

Science

- composition notebook
- graph paper (loose leaf)

- binder with 3 dividers
- 1 roll of paper towels

Math

- ruler
